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Community Partners Working Together for Our Schools

- The Placer Mosquito and Vector Control District will perform a 45 minute “What Bugs You?” assembly. The assembly is designed to teach students (2nd -5th grade) how they can be smart about protecting themselves from “bad bugs,” learn about the science behind certain bugs, and what scientists do right here in Placer County to protect our community. We want to help kids understand what they can do to protect themselves from mosquito bites. And of course, there will always be games and prizes ... we call it edutainment!
- We explore the lifecycle of the mosquito, learn about mosquitofish – and how they eat mosquitoes, and students get to meet some real scientists virtually!
- After the assembly, we ask students take home a “checklist” to be sure their home is protected. Students and their parents sign the checklist and return it to their teacher (1 week turnaround). We will collect the entries and pull a winner from your school to receive a fun gift pack from PMVCD.
- Assemblies will be scheduled February, March, April or May 2023.
