OCTOBER HIGHLIGHTS

We coordinated an interview with CBS 13 about late-season mosquito abundance. This
interview aired Monday November 10th and featured Jake covering Placer County
activity. It was later featured nationally on Yahoo News:



- Casey met with a group of UC Davis entomology students in Auburn to give them handson experience with tick flagging. I went also and got some footage for a social media feature to highlight the collaboration and partnership.
- On Friday November 14th we dropped off cold weather supplies for veterans that we
 gathered internally to the Newcastle Community Hall. These supplies went toward their
 Warming Veterans Hearts event the following day.
- I submitted abstracts to both AMCA and MVCAC to speak about how the Accreditation in Public Relations credential can help to provide a strategic roadmap to help mosquito control districts achieve their communications goals.
- I served as emcee for a regional training day held at the Sutter County Community Center.
- We produced and published several reel-format videos for social media. The topics of
 these reels included promoting our receptionist opening, Veterans Day & Thanksgiving
 office closures, a West Nile virus positivity rate in dead birds summary for 2025, Brent
 and Casey collaborating on larvae collection and identification, an operations highlight,
 a program review visit from CDPH, our veterans cold weather supply drive drop-off, a
 tick flagging field trip we did with some UC Davis entomology students, and the regional
 training day we participated in.







Adult Mosquito Abundance


 Culex tarsalis and Culex pipiens, our primary vector species for West Nile virus (WNV), abundance has substantially decreased in the month of November.

Vector-borne Disease Testing

- o The last WNV positive mosquito sample detected in Placer County was on September 24th.
- West Nile virus disease testing reporting will stop for the winter and resume in Summer 2026.

Tick Collections:

- o Placer Mosquito collected 546 ticks from 10 trails throughout the county this November.
- Steven's trail, located near Colfax, was particularly heavy, containing 39.3% of the total ticks collected.
- Two new walking trails on the west side of Roseville are being investigated this year for tick abundance.
- o This month has seen a 16.1% and 29.3% increase from 2022 and 2023 respectively.
